March 2021 Addis Ababa Ethiopia **Course Description:** This is a 3 days basic COVID-19 surveillance training for surveillance officers and health professionals on COVID-19 surveillance. It enables them to screen passengers, investigate COVID-19 suspected cases, identify, list and follow contacts.

Course Goal: To provide participants with necessary knowledge, skill and attitude needed to undertake COVID-19 surveillance

Learning Objectives: By the end of this training course, the participant will be able to:

- Describe approaches to public health surveillance mean
- Identify COVID-19 surveillance strategies
- Apply passenger screening principles
- Discuss approach of both alert & outbreak investigations
- Appraise contact tracing principles

Participant Selection Criteria

- participants of this course should be surveillance officers and other health professionals who:
- Are currently working as surveillance officers
- Will get engaged in COVID-19 surveillance

Method of evaluation

Participant

Formative

- Pre-test
- Group exercises

Summative

- Knowledge assessment (80%): Post-test questionnaire
- Participant's activity (20%): Attendance and participation

Course:

- Daily Evaluation
- Daily trainer's feedback evaluation
- End of Course evaluation

Certification Criteria: Participants will be certified when they score more than 70% in the summative assessment

Trainer's Selection Criteria

Who trained long term (6 months and above) surveillance training

Involved in at least one in-service surveillance training material

development

Involved in COVID-19 pandemic response

Trained on facilitation skill.

Course Venue: Accommodative Hall (Well ventilated, well illuminated) separate rooms for

group work, audio-visual training and support training centers.

Suggested class size: Accommodates 20-25 participants and 5 trainers.

Course Duration: Three days

Course Composition: 25 participants, 5 trainers
